### PROPOSAL RECOMMENDATIONS

- Workshops should allow for participants to gain new knowledge and/ or skills. Furthermore, participants should be given an opportunity to exercise those skills.
- Workshop content should be engaging and interactive; avoid over-extended lectures, non-participatory activities, etc.
- Make sure your workshop proposal has a clear goal in the description (i.e. what will participants walk away with).
- Titles Matter! Participants pick workshops based on the title.
- Please be clear and concise in your proposal.
- Show you'll use the time well. Workshops are 75 minutes, including 10 minutes for evaluations.

## **PROPOSAL REVIEW**

Workshop proposals for the 27th Annual Models of Pride Conference received by 11:59pm Pacific Time on June 19, 2019 will be reviewed for consideration by the workshops committee. Workshops received after the submission date may not be considered. The committee is made up of staff, volunteers, and youth who are knowledgeable in topics related to LGBTQ+ culture and history.

The Workshops Committee does not guarantee that your workshop proposal will be selected. Workshops are selected through a thorough review process, with a strong emphasis on youth input and intersectionality. Because you have submitted and were selected to present a workshop at a Models of Pride Conference in the past, does not guarantee your workshop application will be selected again this year. Selection is solely at the discretion of the Committee. Presenters may be required to share their workshop content and/or additional content before the conference with staff.

## **CONSIDERATIONS FOR SELECTION**

- Relevance to the LGBTQ+ community, history, and topics.
- Depth of workshop content
- Overall strength of the workshop submission (this is especially the case for presenters from previous years)

The 2019 Workshops Committee reserves the right to reject proposals. Workshops accepted for this year's conference will be notified on or after July 19, 2019.

## **PRESENTER RESPONSIBILITIES & EXPECTATIONS**

- All presenters who are 24 and under are welcomed to join the conference as a youth when not presenting a workshop and must register separately.
- All facilitators in the Parent and Professional Institute are welcomed to join the other workshops and must register separately.
- The person submitting the application is expected to disseminate all workshop information to co-facilitators, panelists, etc.
- No honorariums will be provided; however, meals will be provided this year to all presenters
- Communicate in a timely manner (will mostly be via email)
- Show up on the day of the conference
- Respect all identities & abilities
- Additional information to be provided if your proposal is selected
